Other benefits include tax holidays, tariff exemptions, and priority use of land and property.


Since its designation as a Free Trade Zone in 2002, Daebul has grown into a global business center and now leads the green and high-tech industries.





Eligibility to lease facilities

- Foreign invested companies(manufacturing or knowledge-based service industries):
 Foreign investment of more than KRW 100 million and foreign investor ownership of more than 10% of total outstanding shares or total capital.
- Export-oriented manufacturers: Exports must account for at least 30(30~50)% of the company's sales for the year prior to the lease application date.
- Trade-related wholesalers: At least 30(30~50) % of the company's sales must have involved trade during the year prior to the lease application date.
- Service providers: Financial institutions, insurance companies, customs offices, IT service providers, etc.

- Exemption from corporate and income taxes.
- Manufacturing(investment of more than USD 10 million): For 5years(100% for first 3 years; 50% for the following 2 years)
- Local taxes (acquisition tax, registration tax, etc.):
 100% for 15 years



□ Tariff exemptions

- All foreign and domestic products delivered to the Free Trade Zone will be exempt from tariffs.

□ VAT exemption

- All domestic products delivered to the Free Trade Zone will be exempt from VAT.
- All tenants distributing imported products or providing services within the Free Trade Zone will be exempt from VAT.


